

Dear Washington State Laboratories,

On February 18th the Washington – Department of Ecology (DOE), Laboratory Accreditation Unit, sent an email to all WA-DOE accredited laboratories reminding of a new policy that requires laboratory proficiency testing (PT) data to be submitted via an electronic data deliverable (EDD).

For your PT data to be evaluated and to maintain your accreditation, your PT data must be supplied in the WA-DOE electronic format to the Laboratory Accreditation Unit by your PT provider.

Your Accreditation is Safe with Phenova

As a result of the new policy, PT providers who do not provide EDDs are at risk of being removed from the WA-DOE approved provider list.

Phenova has been supplying and continues to supply EDDs to many states, including Washington, in the many different formats requested by the state accrediting bodies for many years.

Visit Washington's DOE website with the list of requirements and approved proficiency testing providers to ensure your provider is supplying the properly formatted EDD.
